# STATS AND FACTS

The UAI database is an important tool for every local and national association. This database enables us to stay in contact with readers – both members and non-members, allows us to put readers in touch with each other to create study groups, and provide tangible information about how well we are living up to our mission. Every local association should make it a priority to keep your part of the database up-to-date.

According to our Urantia Association International database we have:

1399 full members808 Associate members41 Members-at-large182 Governing Board membersTotal Members = 2430

Non-members in our database = 1660

We have 44 local associations, 10 national associations.

The United States has 756 members (all levels) So, that is 40% USA and 60% non-USA. USA is largest in membership with Brazil and Canada being #2 and #3 respectively.

Of the non-members in our database, 977 (59%) are USA and 683 (41%) are outside the USA.

At the end of 2008 we had 1659 members (all levels). Today, we have 2430. Some of this increase is due to growth of the membership and some is due to local associations doing a better job of using the database. Additional information will soon be available in the UAI Annual Report.

## WHAT IS UAI DOING AND HOW CAN YOU HELP?

Regular monthly contributors are the basis for our strength as an organization that is bringing man closer to God, introducing God as the loving Father of all mortals, and all mortals as the brotherhood of man. We do this by sharing the teachings of The Urantia Book with people around the world.

Regular monthly contributions, no matter how small or large, enable us to be wiser in our budgeting and planning for the coming year. We have many contributors who contribute \$10 per month by credit card. Several contributors give more. Currently, less than 1% of our members contribute to UAI at the international level. I have no way of knowing what this number is within the local associations.

Our contributors enabled us to purchase books from the Foundation and then offer them for only \$8 per book to our members and associations. Our contributors allowed us to produce the new "What is UAI?" brochure in three languages. We introduced this new brochure at the Spain conference and it was very well received. I am in the process of distributing this wonderful tool to all associations for their use.

Our contributors enabled many people from far away places to meet their brothers and sisters in Malaga. I cannot tell you with words how important that was to these people and to all of us.

Contributors paid for an upgrade to our database that allows us to do nearly all the maintenance of the database ourselves. The database if critical to our ability to serve readers. Contributors helped us to send leaders to Malawi, Zambia, and Korea to meet readers there and create new associations (Gaetan and Gary committed a lot of their own time and income to this effort). In just a short time, Zambia has grown to 64 readers and their president, Joel Mvula attended our conference in Malaga. Joel is an exceptional leader who is doing great things in Zambia.

We have other associations that will be coming along soon as they achieve the 10 full members needed to form an association. As you all know, our local associations are servants to all readers in their areas. So, the more associations we form, the more people we serve and the better job we can do by serving them with local people.

Your contributions allowed us to send 6 books to an interfaith study group in South Africa that is studying The Urantia Book as part of their research. Our relationship with this group is growing because of this. Contributors could help us to provide for expenses as our study group chairman, James Woodward, travels to visit with study groups in many countries to strengthen existing groups and to create new groups.

We will be attending the World Interfaith Conference in Australia this year and our associations in Australia are leading the way on this. This is our opportunity to get our message out to the leaders of all the major religions of this planet which can only benefit the spiritual growth of this world. We need your financial support in order to do things like this.

The International Service Board is in the process of developing an intranet that will provide another great tool for our local associations to be more efficient and to reduce the amount of work needed by sharing information among all our associations. This intranet will provide local associations a place to store documents without fear of losing them to a computer crash or a change of staff.

We are also planning a leadership training event in 2011 that will bring leaders of the Urantia revelation, both in and out of UAI, together to share methods and problem solving solutions with each other and to receive training that will benefit their local dissemination activities and their personal growth.

Your contributions allow us to provide study group starter kits at no cost to those wanting them in order to create new study groups. Your contributions allow us to continue our support of Urantia Foundation both financially and with reader services. And, let me while I am at it, mention the need for an office and a full time staff person to handle the many emails, phone calls, and daily needs of running UAI.

Sorry for the long email but I get excited about what we are doing and what we can do to serve our Father and all his children of Urantia.

Urantia Foundation Library Placement Policy ~ January 2009

Urantia Foundation is committed to disseminating the teachings of The Urantia Book around the world. One way this may be accomplished is by donating free copies of the book to libraries and

other places where new readers may discover it. To date, thousands of books have been placed in public libraries around the world. For individuals and groups who want to participate in our library placement program, Urantia Foundation offers the following book sale terms:

English and Spanish hard cover books will sell for \$10.00 each, up to 10 books at a time, plus shipping. Other translations will sell for \$10.00 each, plus shipping, based on availability. Contact Urantia Foundation at 773-525-3319 or www.urantia.org <a href="http://www.urantia.org/">http://www.urantia.org/></a> for current information on translation availability.

We ask that you agree to use these books only for placement in libraries and similar environments, and that they not be used for personal or commercial purposes. Suggested placement settings include:

a. College and university libraries; b. Public libraries; c. Religious libraries (seminaries, churches, ashrams, synagogues, etc.); d. Hotel, youth hostel, cruise ship, and other libraries provided for travelers; e. Hospital libraries; f. Highly trafficked private libraries; g. Coffee shops with "free book" shelves; h. Waiting rooms and other places where people may be looking for something to read.

It is important to obtain permission from the librarian or shop owner before placing the book at a site. If permission is not received the book may be discarded.

In return for the discount we are offering on new books, we would appreciate your letting us know where you placed them. Any additional information that you consider helpful will be most welcomed. We will publish results of this program from time to time, and if you would like to write about your experiences, we will consider featuring your report in Urantia Foundation News Online or on our website.
